Rule 012 - Filing Frequency

Filling frequency is determined by the St. John the Baptist Parish Sales and Use Tax Office at the point a business registers. Most businesses are initially assigned a monthly filing frequency. Filing frequency is then reconsidered after a liability history has been developed.

We have instituted four (3) different filing frequencies. They are:

Monthly - Average liability of \$100 or more per month.

Quarterly – Average liability of \$200 or more, but less than \$300 per quarter.

Occasional – Liability that is incurred on a one-time or very infrequent basis.

A taxpayer's filing frequency in referenced on their sales/use tax return. Taxpayers are notified if a filling frequency change is made and when the change will take effect.

NOTE: Annual filing frequency was discontinued in 2021.
